WHAT IS A CSA?

You become a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) member by purchasing a subscription for a share of the harvest from a local farm. In return, you'll receive just-picked produce and more throughout the growing season directly from your farmer.

Your share is conveniently delivered to a pick-up site near you - or home delivered. Each share contains fresh seasonal produce (and perhaps meat, eggs, honey or other extras) along with a farm newsletter and recipes.

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is much more than just a weekly delivery of food. It is a powerful investment in your health, your family's health, your community, and your local economy.

WHY BUY DIRECTLY FROM THESE LOCAL FARMERS?

- » Enjoy fresh, tasty and healthy food throughout the growing season.
- » Get to know your food, where and how it's grown, and the people who grow it.
- » Expand the variety of vegetables you eat.
- » Support the local economy and ensure fair compensation for small family farmers.
- » Encourage sustainable growing practices that protect our soils, water and health.

SUGGESTED QUESTIONS TO HELP YOU FIND A CSA FARM:

You'll find many of the answers in this handout. There is also contact information for each farm to help you learn more.

- » Locations, days and times of your **pick-up sites**? Do you offer home delivery?
- » What is the **length of your season** / number of deliveries?
- » Describe the **sizes, contents and costs of your shares**. How many people would each feed? Do you have a policy for holding or skipping shares when I'm on **vacation**? Any **choices** about what's in the box?
- » **Options & extras**. What's offered besides produce? Do you have an online or farm store?
- » **Payment**. Do you offer worker shares (an option to work in exchange for my CSA box)? Payment (installment) plans? Have a financial Assistance Fund? Can I use a credit card or electronic / online payment?
- » What are your **growing and production practices**? For example, certified organic? Sustainably grown?
- » **Can I visit your farm**? Do you have open houses or farm events?
